The Ithaca PTSO is a volunteer group comprised of parents, teachers, students and members of the Ithaca community that works toward the improvement of the school. We meet on the **3rd Wednesday at 3:30 pm in the Library** from September through May to discuss ideas, problems, fundraisers, events, etc. All monies taken in from our fundraisers go back into the school and the community. Last spring we donated \$3000 to the Playground Improvement Project and have several new activities planned for the 2017-18 school year.

Each year we:

- Provide welcome baskets for new teachers and staff
- Provide meals to teachers during the two parent-teacher conferences
- Donate snacks for the Elementary and Middle school science fairs
- Recognize our school volunteers during National Volunteer Week
- Sponsor the *Semester Star* High School recognition program
- Publish the all color elementary school yearbook and new this year a Middle School yearbook
- Supply popcorn for the Elementary school Friday popcorn sales
- Offer a "Welcome to Ithaca" goodie bag for our incoming 4K students
- Serve the staff a "thank you" breakfast during Teacher/Staff Appreciation Week in May with the NHS
- Sponsor the Million Minutes reading reward bounce house and frozen treats
- Award a scholarship to a deserving graduation senior
- Present retiring staff with a token of appreciation

This year the PTSO is sponsoring a bounce house, games, face painting, cotton candy, and sno cones at the Ithaca Fair. We are also planning a Holiday Store for the elementary children and hosting a Gingerbread House Making contest in December along with sponsoring a 4K adult/child crafts and snacks program with Mrs. Penfield.

The PTSO has many fundraisers including the Ithaca sportswear/spirit items drive, elementary and middle school year books, the RR1 Popcorn sale coming in October, and a silent auction in December (in time for Christmas!). The Ithaca PTSO also has several collection based fundraisers that account for a portion of our income throughout the school year. The labels programs **Boxtops 4 Education, Tyson Project A+ Support Your School, Kwik Trip Milk Moola, and new this year Loaves 4 Learning through Country Hearth/Village Hearth** are utilized to raise money for supplies for the school.
